Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. I am Ramesh Pal. I got 92 % marks in Madhyamik Examination. My Higher Secondary marks are as follows:

Subjects	Full Marks	Marks obtained
Bengali	100	85
English	100	91
Mathematics	100	93
Physics	100	94
Chemistry	100	92
Biology	100	83

How merit point will be calculated?

Answer: Percentage in Madhyamik Examination=92% & Percentage in Higher Secondary Examination=91%.

Merit point= 40 % of percentage of Madhyamik Examination + 60% of percentage in Higher Secondary Examination

=36.8+54.6

=91.4

- How I calculate percentage of Higher Secondary marks? Answer: Percentage of Higher Secondary marks will be calculated on the basis of best five marks.
- 3. Is the mark obtained in ENVS are in best five marks in HS Examination? Answer: If ENVS is the Compulsory Elective, then the obtained marks in ENVS is considered in best five marks otherwise not.
- 4. I passed Higher Secondary Examination in the year 2017. Can I apply in your institution in a course for the session 2021-22?

Answer: No. As per Burdwan University norms and regulation, we allow the pass out students of the year 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 in any course for the session 2021-22.

5. Can I get refund of admission fee after cancelation of my admission? Answer: Amount of admission fee will be refunded in full if any applicant cancels his admission within 31/10/2021. Otherwise processing fee will be deducted if he cancels his admission within 31/12/2021. Processing fee will be maximum Rs.1000/-.

6. Can I shift from one admitted subject to other subject ?

Answer: Yes, you can shift from one admitted Honours subject/General Course to another Honours subject/General Course, if confirmed. You will get this opportunity for one time. (In this case admission fees will be adjusted automatically).
