

2.5.2 - Mechanism to deal with internal examination related grievances is transparent, time- bound and efficient

Response:

Periodic class examinations are organized by the departments to assess the progress of the students. Students are provided with answer scripts, and remedial classes are designed to accommodate those who progress slowly. Vivekananda Mahavidyalaya has established a resilient mechanism to guarantee the transparency and efficacy of the continuous assessment process. The college maintains a distinct Examination Committee for each semester, which is responsible for overseeing the administration of both internal and university examinations and resolving any complaints pertaining to exams. All examinations, including those at the conclusion of the semester, were administered by the institution under the direction of the affiliating university throughout the pandemic. The examination committee effectively addressed every concern pertaining to examinations, attaching answer scripts, and other related matters. Sufficient accommodations are provided for students' attendance on academic reasons and engagement in extracurricular pursuits. Concerns regarding end-of-semester examinations at the university level are relayed from the college to the university administration. A student who is unsatisfied with his or her grades may, upon payment of the prescribed charge, request a review of his or her answer script whenever the university so requests. Students are granted photocopies of their answer sheets in violation of their Right to Information, and the university takes appropriate corrective action.
